What young people should demonstrate through their evidence:

Part A: Discover

- An understanding of how the arts encompass a range of art forms from the familiar to the unfamiliar
- Participation in arts activities
- An understanding of how art forms connect to their own lives

Evidence Required:

- At least two art forms identified
- Participation in at least one arts activity

Part B: Find out

Knowledge of at least one artist and their work

Evidence Required:

• A record of what they found out about at least one artist and their work

Part C: Share

- What they enjoyed and learnt through the award
- How they shared their experience with others

Evidence Required:

• Which parts of their enjoyment and learning were shared and who they shared it with

Advisers look at the evidence in the arts logs as a whole in order to find one notable example of each of the assessment criteria listed below.

Art form knowledge and understanding

Pass: A basic understanding of a range of art forms.

Creativity

Pass: Show commitment in arts activities.

Communication

Pass: A basic understanding of communication.

IDEAS FOR ACTIVITIES
